1. Reading: USA, land of immigrants

- Check pictures in Unit 4: What do you recognize [¹rekəgnɑɪz, dt: "erkennen, begreifen"]?
- Read the text at page 152/ 153. Don' t hesitate to read it aloud and or to someone at home. What is the text about?
- Check new words
- Draw a mind map: Who came to the US/ Northern America during the ages?
EXTRA: You may design your mind map like a map of the USA

2. Writing: Why do people leave their home country?

- Collect reasons (you may ask your family, friends...). And you can re-read texts at page 80/ 81.
- Write about ten sentences.
EXTRA: Try to vary the beginning of your sentences, e.g.¹ "There are many reasons why..."/ "In the beginning, there were...", "When....", "Many people decide to...", "I think that...", "I have learned that...", "According to...", "Another important reason is...", "We don't have to forget that..."

3. Grammar: Revise conditional sentences, type 1 + 2

- Write five "if-" sentences about immigration, e.g.
"If there was a great danger in my home town, I would ..."

¹ e.g. is an abbreviation, it comes from latin "exempli gratia", meaning "for example" (like ger. z.B.)
