Tasks for the Wednesday lessons + homework

1. Take the solutions to the "test" you wrote in your second "Corona-week" and write a correction. Underline your mistakes and correct everything three times and in full sentences.
2. Take the solutions to the tasks in your workbook, which you were supposed to do in the third "Corona-week" and correct your solutions (solutions are sent in our "virtual classroom").
3. Take your textbook "Candem Market" and re-read page 85.
 - a. Copy "16R Imperativ (The imperative)" on page 205 into your exercise books.
 - b. Take your workbook and solve page 60, no. 8 & 9.
4. Repeat your vocabulary up to page 237 "reason – Grund" (Theme 4).
 - a. Make sure you repeat all words from theme 1 – 4 until you have learnt them by heart (also make sure that you know how to spell them).
 - i. Usually it is more important to translate from German into English, but make sure you are able to do it either way.

Tasks for the Thursday lesson + homework

5. Take your text book and open it to page 210.
 - a. Copy "22R Die Satzstellung (Word order)" into your exercise books.
 - b. Take your work book and solve page 61, no. 10 a.
 - c. Take your textbook again and copy "R2 Die einfache Gegenwart (The simple present)" (pp. 193/194) into your exercise books.
 - i. also "4R Die einfache Vergangenheit (The simple past)" on pp. 195/196.
 - ii. Solve task 10b in your work book.
 - d. Afterwards, do task 11 a & b in your workbook.
