settlers (start) fighting. Pocahontas, the chief's daughter, was kidnapped by		
the settlers.		
While living with the English settlers, s	he	(meet) a man called John Rolfe and
(fall) in love	with him. They	(get) married in April
1614. In late spring 1616 Pocahontas	and John	(have) a baby. After the baby

very happy when they finally (arrive) after a long and difficult journey.
